Getting to services

Accessibility is people's ability to reach the things they need or want to do – such as work, learning, healthcare, shopping and leisure activities – at reasonable cost, in reasonable time and with reasonable ease.

Accessibility depends on several things:

- Does transport exist between the people and the service?
- Do people know about the transport, trust its reliability and feel safe using it?
- Are people physically and financially able to access transport?
- Are the services and activities within a reasonable distance?
