Winter gritting service

Lancashire County Council is working with organisations across the county to keep traffic on the county's roads moving when the bad weather strikes. In an ideal world we would treat every road in Lancashire but in reality it isn't possible or economical to do so. The county council therefore prioritises those roads and pavements that it is most important to keep clear. In periods of prolonged severe weather we will treat other routes where possible.

The county council is responsible for over 4,300 miles of road of which approximately 1,500 miles are part of Lancashire's Priority Road Network for salting and snow clearing. Our salt stocks are built up at 15 locations across the county and our fleet of gritters and snow ploughs are ready to start work as soon as ice and snow is forecast.

The Highways Agency has the responsibility of treating the following major roads and Motorways - M6, M61, M55, M65 (J1 to J10), M58, A56 (from M65 to M66) and A585 (from M55 to Fleetwood).

Heysham-M6 link

The county council has received the green light on funding to build a road linking the Heysham and Morecambe peninsula to the M6 motorway.

The Heysham-M6 link road will attract investment in the area by providing better access to Morecambe, the port and industrial areas on the peninsula and, along with additional measures to manage traffic as part of the scheme, reduce congestion through Lancaster city centre. Construction alone will employ over 3,000 people. A minimum of 100 local unemployed people will receive training and jobs during construction.

Depending on the new timescales, construction could begin in 2012 with the road opened to traffic in 2015.

Budget

Lancashire County Council's cabinet recently published a three-year budget proposal.

Rather than the usual annual budget process, the county council looked to clarify its future by setting out plans for a £71.7m saving in 2011-12, followed by a further £50m in 2012-13 and another £57.4m in 2013-14 - a total of £179.1m over the next three years. The plans also included new investment in improving the road network and road safety.

Following consultation over the last month, the budget proposals were brought back to the cabinet meeting on 3 February 2011. Cabinet members agreed a final budget recommendation to go to the full meeting of the county council for approval shortly after this questionnaire was finalised.
